What looks like an ordinary item, such as a water bottle or hairbrush, may actually be a "diversion safe," used to stash drugs and drug-related paraphernalia. These containers are easily purchased online and at local retailers. This interactive experience challenges parents and caregivers to try to find the **more than 100 hidden items**, including:

- Mock drugs
- Seemingly real containers that are actually "Stash Safes"
- Drug paraphernalia
- Common household items that can indicate abuse
