2019 Roadway Paving Project

Zoning/Code Enforcement

A *Certificate of Occupancy* "C.O." is required prior to selling your home OR if you are a landlord, prior to a new tenant moving into your unit. Please come to the Borough Office to pick up an inspection application packet. Permit applications for decks, sheds, pools, fences, etc. can be obtained in the Borough Office or on the Borough Website under the "Forms" tab.

Shannon Calluori of CodeMaster Inspection Services is our Borough Zoning Officer & Building Code Official. She can be reached via email scalluori@codemaster.info or by phone. Her office hours at the Borough Office are Tuesday (8am-10am) and Friday (1pm-3pm) - starting September Friday hours (2pm-4pm).

Sanitation & Sewer Billing Information

Enclosed you will find Sewer Invoice for the second period of 2019. The cost is \$122/unit (not billed based on consumption). Please remember your Sewer Invoice (always printed on colored paper) is billed directly from the Borough Office and your water bill is billed directly from the City of Bethlehem. Their bill states "water and sewer" but it is ONLY for your water usage.

Past due Sanitation and Sewer Invoices can be paid with cash, check, or money order at the Borough Office, secured lockbox outside Borough Office, through the mail, or through your bank's online bill pay system. Please remember to include your account number in memo section.
