Your best friend's best chance to make it home safely is to be properly licensed.

All dogs 3 months of age or older are required by Pennsylvania law to have a current dog license.

Failure to have your dog licensed may result in a fine of up to \$300.

How much does a license cost?

Annual license fees are as follows:

General:

Dogs that are spayed or neutered	\$6.45
Dogs not spayed or neutered	\$8,45

Senior citizens (65 years of age and older) or persons with proof of disability:

Dogs that are spayed or neutered	\$4 .45
Dogs not spayed or neutered	\$6.45.
