All dogs 3 months of age or older
are required by Pennsylvania law to
have a current dog license.

**Failure to have your dog
licensed may result in a
fine of up to \$300.**



How much does a license cost?

Annual license fees are as follows:

General:

Dogs that are spayed or neutered..... \$6.45

Dogs not spayed or neutered \$8.45

Senior citizens (65 years of age and older)

or persons with proof of disability:

Dogs that are spayed or neutered..... \$4.45

Dogs not spayed or neutered \$6.45 .
