Zoning

If you are planning any type of project at your residence, please contact zoning to determine whether a permit is required. For any dumpster requests, you must visit the office in person to complete a dumpster permit. Failure to comply will result in a fine equal to twice the cost of the permit.

Recycling & Bulk Trash

Recycling is now CURBSIDE!!! Pickup will be the last Tuesday of every month. You can either use your plastic container if you have already have purchased one OR clear plastic bags. All recyclables can go in together providing they are clean and dry. If you have any bulk items, you may come into the Administrative Office Mon-Thu 9-3 to purchase Bulk Tags. All tags must be purchased no later than 3:00 on the Tuesday of that week for the item(s) to be picked on trash day.

Sewer & Sanitation & Real Estate Taxes

Your Sewer bill is now just 1 time per year. Just like the Sanitation bill, you may make partial payments up to your due date of 9/8/2025. You will no longer receive 3 bills for sewer.

PLEASE PAY ALL UTILITIES WITH SEPARATE CHECKS.

You may continue to pay your Real Estate Taxes at the borough Tue 9-12 & Thu 12-3. SEPARATE CHECK.

We are currently making plans to begin accepting credit card payments in 2026.

Police

Freemansburg Borough and our neighboring municipalities have been seeing an increase in vehicle break-ins during the overnight hours. The crimes that have been reported to date have been opportunistic crimes – meaning that the crimes are targeting random unlocked vehicles. We ask that you lock your vehicles at all times when they are not in use and refrain from leaving any valuable items inside in plain view. If you encounter a vehicle break-in in progress, we ask that you do not intervene and call 911 immediately.
